

The unique curriculum of "Workshop on Lead Management" has been developed by Prof. Dr. S. Boveda, Workshop Director in close collaboration with Prof. Dr. Brugada, Course Director. This course offers a unique opportunity to learn about techniques and to interact with world experts on innovative treatment options for lead management. To reach maximal interaction while discussing on challenging cases and live procedures, only a small group of selected EPs (max 12) is invited to participate in this course.
